The link will get you to a simple explanation of what park flyer membership is and the Academy of Model Aeronautics (AMA) web site. All radio control aircraft, drones etc. come under Unmanned Aerial Systems (UAS) FAA regulations which require all UAS operators to be registered with the FAA and to display their FAA number on the outside of their aircraft and carry their FAA registration card.

Fort Nugent Park in Oak Harbor has a flying club chartered by the AMA so they self regulate. I enjoy flying at the south Whidbey soccer fields, and when done by the rules it is safe. I never fly when people are on the field, all other activities take priority over flying. This is true at Fort Nugent too. I usually fly from 7:00 to 9:00 on week days with almost nobody there. As an AMA member I am interested in keeping our hobby safe and well regarded in the community. Please feel free to contact me if I can be of help.
