Dear Mr. Pryor:

It has come to the District's attention that you have been constructing an unauthorized trail from your property at 5829 Pioneer Park Place onto Park District property at the Trustland Trails site to connect to an existing trail from your neighbor's property that connects to the public trail system. This trail construction has not been authorized by the South Whidbey Parks and Recreation District Board of Commissioners and as currently laid out is almost entirely within the 50-foot non-construction buffer from the property line that the District has established for all trails constructed on this property.

You have neither asked for nor received permission to construct this trail on District property and the District demands that you immediately cease and desist in all construction on this trail, abandon the trail as an access point to the Trustland Trails property, and let it go back to a natural state (allowing any cut plant life to grow in and cover the trail).

If I have not received an affirmative response from you by 10/31/19 indicating that you have fully complied with these requirements, I shall consider taking any and all legal remedies available to rectify this situation.
