## Director's Items

Working with the committees, I have completed all seven of the grant applications and submitted then through the RCO's portal. I have since reached out to committee members to solicit letters of support for the projects to include in the presentations/applications and myself have reached out to local government entities to get letters of support from them if possible. Matt has produced a powerpoint for the Aquatic facility grant and I will be using that presentation as a template for the additional 4 powerpoint presentations to be completed prior to the Technical Review presentations in June.

With Freeland Hall, I have reached out to the County for additional information on the situation with the relationship with the Holmes Harbor Activities Club. I told them that since the story broke in the newspaper, our board felt we should discuss things further before proceeding with anything else on the property.

Working with King Water and Davido to try to get our SMSMP approved by ecology and then by the State Health Department. There are still some items that ecology needs from our water testing prior to approval. Working to get those done and reported to them.
