## **Aquatic Wellness Center**

The Joint Pool Committee has scheduled interviews with the two firms that sent in their qualifications for the Design of the Aquatic Wellness Center and should have feedback on these for the meeting. Potentially a recommendation on which firm should be approached for a contract. More discussion at the meeting as the scheduled meetings have not yet happened.

## **Grant Applications**

We have heard back on the initial ranking for all the grant applications and the results are as follows:

WWRP-Local Parks	
Pickleball	26 <sup>th</sup>
Amphitheater	30 <sup>th</sup>
Artificial Turf Sports Field	31 <sup>st</sup> -Tied

LWCF	
Amphitheater	24 <sup>th</sup>

Youth Athletic Facilities	
Artificial Turf Sports Field	8 <sup>th</sup>
Pickleball Courts	24 <sup>th</sup>

What does this mean? We will discuss this at the meeting in more detail, but here are the basics:

It is unlikely that the Amphitheater and the Artificial Turf Field will be funded in the WWRP-Local Parks category. The Pickleball courts stand a chance but could be on the bubble.

Being 24<sup>th</sup> in LWCF, it is unlikely there will be enough funding for the Amphitheater there as well.

In YAF, last year it was funded enough to cover \$10,800,000 in projects. If funded to the same level, both our projects would be funded.
