News:

Pickleball

Runs through Tuesday, November 29th. After that, the multipurpose gym at SWCC will be occupied for the Holiday House for the month of December. No alternative gym available to use at this time since the Main Gym at SWCC is still under construction.

- 866 individual sessions paid via drop-in fee, punch card purchase, or pre-pay registration.

Youth Basketball

Registration opening the end of November for youth league. 1st/2nd & 3rd/4th grade leagues will begin in early January. 5th/6th grade league on hold until SWCC main gym is finished with construction.

The SWHS boys' basketball coach and players will be running basketball clinics for 5th-8th graders through us at the high school on Saturdays beginning Dec 3 and running through the end of January.

Whidbey Island Triathlon

Saturday, July 22nd is the tentative date. Waiting on timing company to finalize contract. We have first right of refusal for the 4th Saturday in July since we used that date in 2022.

Adult Volleyball

Have a local group that has expressed interest in starting up drop-in volleyball again. Am working with the school district to use one of their gyms on Sundays beginning in January.

In need of hiring a gym supervisor to help with setup/breakdown of pickleball, futsal, basketball, and volleyball in the months ahead.

Facilities and Grounds

- Austin and I have been trying to restore access throughout our park system. We have half of Trustland Trails cleaned up hope to do more next week. We have dealt with over 80 trees so far.
- Two trees hit the water tank and I had Cato Smith come out with his bucket truck to remove them.
- We decommissioned the well and that is wrapped up.
- The Maxwellton Park trails has been started but is on hold while we clean up the entire park.

Director's Items

Most items for the Director's report are in the regular agenda for the meeting. Worked with Carrie on getting items finalized for the 2023 Budget. Met with the Joint Pool Committee (JPC) and ARC to start the contract process. Still awaiting a formal proposal from ARC after we addressed questions they had. Have an additional JPC meeting scheduled for Tuesday November 15th to follow up and review some items. Well decommissioning for Well # 3 on the planned pool site is underway and should be completed prior to the board meeting. Sent out letters to the Tribes that have indicated regional claims to the property in Community Park to comment on the Pool Project. Sent in a form to the Department of Archaeology and Historical Preservation and received a determination of "No Cultural Resources Impact". Worked with the RCO to get another extension (Final one) for the Campground Project until the end of 2023. We have the septic sites for the Campground located and Onsite Septic systems is contacting the county and will work with us for the site registration they need.
