Job Title: Basketball Referee (Parks and Recreation) / Recreation Assistant
Status: Seasonal (January – March)
Pay Rate: Minimum wage up to \$25.00 per hour, DOE

General Statement of Duties

The Basketball Referee is responsible for officiating South Whidbey Parks and Recreation District basketball games. A high level of judgment is necessary to be an Official. Officials are under the direction of the Basketball Coordinator and the Recreation Supervisor.

Duties and Responsibilities

Essential Duties and Tasks

- Officiates basketball games as assigned and enforces the rules of play.
- Communicates with coaches, players, sponsors, and helps maintain order.
- Maintains accurate time sheet and submits them to a designated supervisor.

Additional Job Duties

- May be responsible for locking/unlocking gyms, pushing in/pulling out bleachers, ensuring good stewardship of School District gyms and facilities (may require clean-up).
- Performs related duties as required.
- Weekday evening and/or Saturday work is a requirement. Games are typically held at South Whidbey School District or South Whidbey Community Center gymnasiums
- Other duties as assigned by the recreation supervisor.

Knowledge, Skills, and Abilities

- Candidates must have previous experience with basketball.
- Working knowledge of Rules of Play standard to the game of basketball and the ability to enforce such rules with both verbal and nonverbal communication.
- Must possess the ability to communicate and maintain effective, cooperative, and productive working relationships with coaches, players, spectators, supervisors, and other members of the Parks and Recreation District.
- Must possess the ability to carry out oral and written instructions and posted schedules.
- Ability to appear on time for scheduled games and notify appropriate individuals in advance if unable to work.
- Must be able to dress appropriately, providing shoes for the court. District supplies shirts & whistles.
- Must be able to access and respond to email regularly.

Physical Requirements

- Must be able to physically perform the basic functions of standing, walking, bending, stooping, reaching, hearing, repetitive motions, and jog intermittently.
- Ability to see play with sufficient clarity to make accurate decisions.
